For the summer of 2017, foundry10 is accepting applications from graduate-level students with an interest in studying learning and education. This internship includes both work on foundry10 projects as well as room for academic exploration in your areas of interest and study. While this internship is most applicable to students pursuing advanced degrees in the social sciences, we encourage any graduate students interested in working with youth, understanding learning, and collaborating with like-minded peers and partners to apply.

Included with your resume, please submit a written summary of how you could contribute to our organization, how you would benefit from this experience, and in what ways we could help propel you forward with your research and development goals. If you have an idea for a project, tell us about the research question you would like to answer, how you would do it, and what you would need. Finally, tell us about what topical areas you would like to focus on, although the internship will likely span many different interests.

The hours for this position will depend on the availability of the applicant, from June through August at a rate of \$18/hr.

Foundry10 is a privately funded organization focused on researching student learning, specifically through non-traditional learning methods. Part of our vision is to show and express what learning can look like outside the traditional classroom setting.
